St. Andrew's School is seeking qualified applicants for a full-time religion and philosophy faculty position starting in August 2017. The ideal candidate will be prepared to teach courses in world religions and philosophy to students from a wide range of religious traditions and none at all. A master's degree in religious studies or a related field is preferred.

A typical teaching load consists of four sections of 12-15 students with two preps. Our sophomore year Religious Thought class is question-based, and draws responses from the major religious traditions of the world as well as non-religious philosophies. Teachers have the opportunity to design a senior elective in discussion with the department; recent electives have included Ethics, Religion and Gender, Asian Philosophy and Religion, and Service Learning. The position will also involve full participation in the extracurricular and student life programs of this residential community.

St. Andrew's is a 9th through 12th grade, all-residential, co-ed boarding school of 310 students and 70 faculty, with deep commitments to diversity in all its forms, and to financial aid.
